#### Fire/EMS Department Chief Steve Downey

Three bids were received for quotes to purchase the SCBA air compressor system that was awarded in the AFG grant. The grant amount is \$55,000.00. The only expense the Township will have is the electric drop and the balance of the grant could cover this amount.

Motion# 63-2024 was made by Ms. Aranyos to purchase the SCBA air compressor system for Breathing Air for the price of \$52,402.10. Mr. Peck 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion.

Other discussion:

Purchase of a Fire/EMS Vehicle:

- Ms. Forder has appropriated \$13,000.00 to fund 2181 for a vehicle payment but does not feel comfortable with a new vehicle purchase and suggested purchasing used.
- Mr. Forder is concerned with the amount of milage a new vehicle would have and the warranty would expire within 18 months.
- Mr. Peck ask Chief Downey if a used vehicle would work for a few years. Chief Downey said no.
- Ms. Aranyos feels the residents of the Township would be dissatisfied seeing a new vehicle purchased by the Township when we are currently building an addition and also recently passed a tax levy.
- Guest Speakers Mike Wright would like to volunteer to start a fund to try and collect enough to purchase a vehicle or partial. This could take up to 6 months.

Motion# 64-2024 was made by Ms. Aranyos to have Mike Wright volunteer to start a fund raiser for the vehicle. Mr. Peck 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion.
