## PERMIT EXTENSION/CANCEL REQUEST

The *Ohio Building Code* (OBC) and the *Residential Code of Ohio* (RCO) requires that your approval/permit expire after I-year from the date of approval. The owner/owner's agent can request the extension with payment of an extension fee (\$50.50 residential; \$51.50 commercial).

Code provided options for the length of extension are listed below. Once work has started and the work is delayed or stopped for more than 6 months, the approval of your plans will become invalid. The OBC allows for up to two, 6-month extensions. If approved work is in progress, an extension will not be required, as long as there is a passed or failed inspection by the Clemont County Building Inspection Department occurring every 6 months.

Your Application/Permit will expire if extensions cannot be granted. Any additional work after the application is expired will require a new application, plan review and fees.
